Here are some suggested home learning activities.

You can select as many of the 16 activities to do over the 2 week period.



Write out your spelling words in fancy writing.

Write down 3 things you know about Harry Potter.

Use adjectives to write a description of a character in your reading book.

Create an acrostic poem using POLAR or DESERT.

Read a non-fiction text and write down 3 facts you have learned.

Use your spelling words to write some silly sentences.

Write a book review for your favourite book. Who would you recommend it to? Why?



Can you create a picture using only squares, triangles and rectangles?



Write down 10 (or more!) sums where the answer is **80**.

Can you count in 2s, 3s and 4s from 1 to 100? How quickly can you do this?

Write out the fact family for the 5 times table. Remember you will have 4 sums for each station: two multiplying, two dividing.

Complete a challenge on Sumdog.

Choose a times table to write in rainbow colours.



Create a poster about the importance of good hand hygiene.

Help a family member prepare a meal (and help do the washing up!)

Choose 5 numbers. How many sums can you make using only these?

Create a 10 minute fitness routine. Ask a family member to try it.

Create 5 different number sequences, ask a family member to spot the pattern.

Make a Power point presentation about our topic.

Go out into your garden and play an outdoor game or activity.
