Numeracy - position and movement	<p>Create a treasure map for someone in your house. Give them directions to find the treasure. Phonics

Phoneme = oo

Introduce your child to this week's sound: oo

- Practise saying the sound
- Model letter formation for your child
- Write letter in the air
- Ask your child if they can think of any words with the 'oo' sound

- Practise saying 'oo' words. Try to break them down with your child to focus on the sounds e.g. f-oo-d.

look	pool
	roof

Suggested spelling activities:

- Look at word, cover word, write word then check
- **Flashcards** - make your own colourful flashcards to practise your words with.
- **Sand/Foam** - with your finger, write your words in sand or shaving foam
- **Phonics hunt** - go for a hunt round your house to find any items featuring the 'oo' sound.
