## Phonics

Phoneme = ai

Introduce your child to this week's sound: ai

- Practise saying the sound
- Model letter formation for your child
- Write letter in the air
- Ask your child if they can think of any words with the 'ai' sound

- Practise saying 'ai' words. Try to break them down with your child to focus on the sounds e.g. s-n-ai-l.

**Suggested spelling activities:**

- Look at word, cover word, write word then check
- **Flashcards** - make your own colourful flashcards to practise your words with.
- **Rainbow words** - write each letter of a word using a different colour. (Can be done outside using chalk)
- **Phonics hunt** - go for a hunt round your house to find any items featuring the 'ai' sound.
