




## Suggested weekly Activities

### Primary: 6 - Week Beginning: 1<sup>st</sup> June

Curricular Area	Suggested activities

'Exploring the Deep' is the sixth book on the list. Read the story over a few days and write two paragraphs about your favourite bit.</li> <li>• Bug Club – You should see five books. Choose one book and do the related comprehension.</li> <li>• Sumdog – Weekly Grammar challenge 1<sup>st</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup> June</li> <li>• Education City – 'Move the Goals' and 'Norse Code' assigned under the homework section.</li> <li>• James Clerk Maxwell Comprehension sheet – uploaded separately. There are three levels of difficulty for your child to choose from. Remember to answer in full sentences, copying spelling carefully from the text. Be careful parents – the answers are at the back!</li> </ul>
Literacy - phonics or spelling	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sumdog – Weekly Spelling challenge 1<sup>st</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup> June (the more you play, the more Sumdog learns what words that you personally need to work on) Sumdog Primary 6 Spelling Words – Units 1-9 challenge – A revision of most of the words covered to date. This challenge runs until the end of June.</li> <li>• Spelling City – Wordlists have been created.</li> </ul>
Literacy - writing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Watch Newsround each day and write a paragraph or two describing the most interesting piece of news at the end of the week.</li> <li>• Writing Task – Write a biography about someone you admire. We have uploaded a pdf of a PowerPoint that explains the features of an autobiography and a biography, as well as a pdf checklist of a biography's key features.</li> </ul>
Numeracy: topic	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sumdog – Weekly Maths challenge 1<sup>st</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup> June</li> <li>• Education City – See activities on 'Temperature Line Graphs', 'Using Graphs' and 'Divisible Me' assigned under the homework section.</li> <li>• Mrs Wallace will upload a maths worksheet for your group.</li> <li>• Mental maths practice and Problem Solving Task. (Mrs Wallace will upload)</li> </ul>
